## Cabrillo Beach Coastal Park

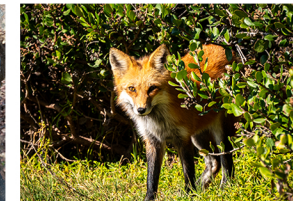

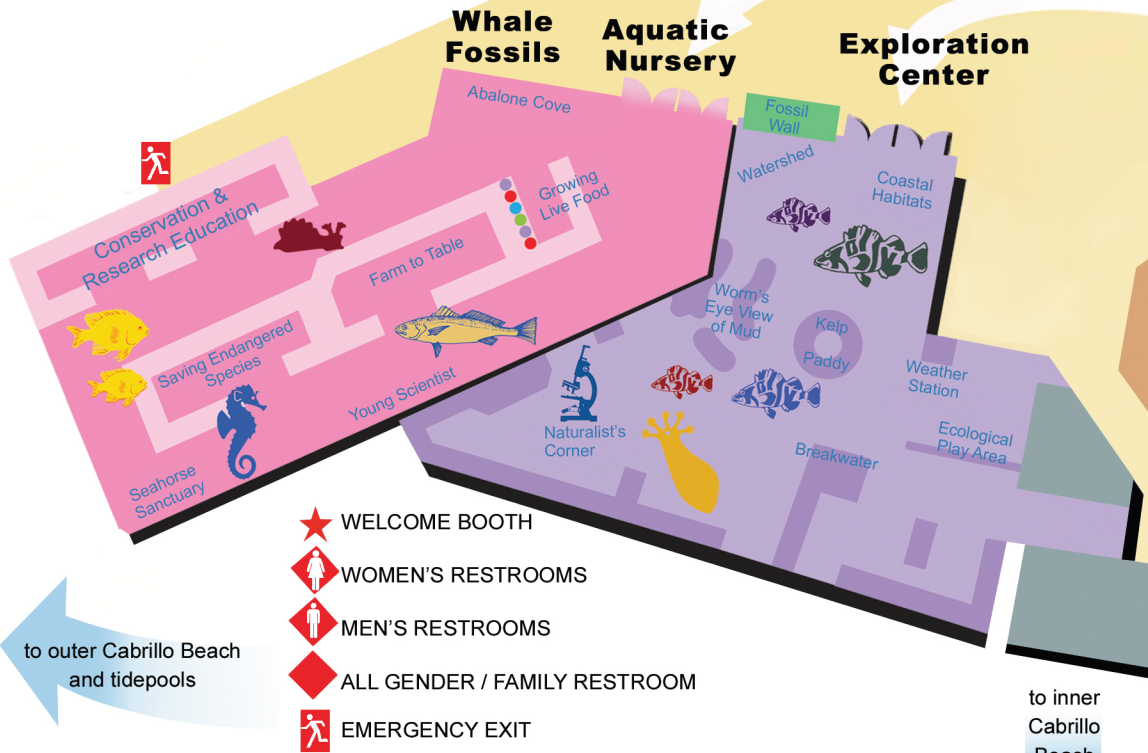
